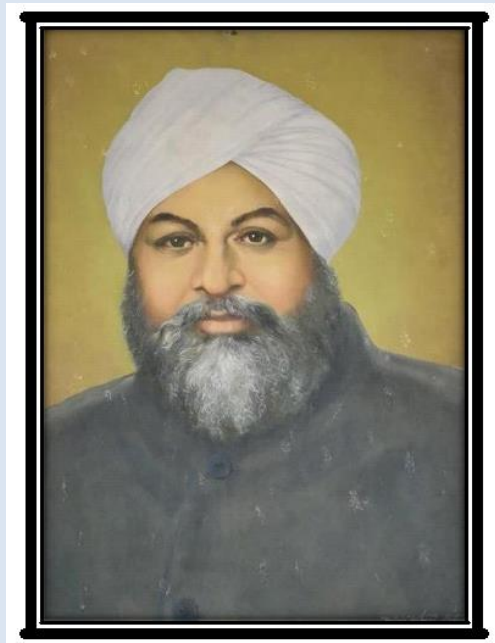

Rules & Regulations

- There is no participation fee for the event. Each Entry must be approved by respective director/principal or competent authority.
- LAST DATE TO CONFIRM PARTICIPATION is 16 January 2022– till 5 PM
- **Students from 9th to 12th class are eligible to participate in all events**
- **All the events will be conducted in ONLINE MODE via Zoom and/or Google Meet in parallel. Kindly send your team according to schedule. Schedule will not be changed to accommodate common participation by the same student.**
- The teacher(s) should be actively available online/on phone during the event.
- The name and contact number (WhatsApp) of contingent incharge of participating school must be sent via google form link :- <https://forms.gle/w4Nc8ydASyNft5a69>
- Only students, currently on rolls, are allowed. Outsiders, professionals/former students/employees are not allowed.
- Any act of indiscipline or misbehavior will lead to disqualification of the participant(s) or full contingent, as the case may be.
- Any presentation against social/professional decorum will lead to disqualification.
- GGNIMT reserves the right to cancel any event.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding in all events. Rules can be changed, if judges desire so. No dispute will be entertained in this regard.
- All entries will have to be submitted in prescribed format in advance. On the spot entries may not be entertained.
- The online links for participants will be shared to registered participants/teachers only via WhatsApp a day before the event.
- Two prizes will be declared in each event viz. 1st and 2nd
- E-certificates will be given to all participants

SUMMARY OF EVENT RULES

1. FOLK SONG (SOLO) 10 AM onwards

- Maximum 2 individual entries per school are allowed.
- The participant will sing live online. The link will be shared a day before. Only singing quality will be main consideration for judgement.
- The participants can sing using recorded music or live music (whatever is feasible).
- Song may be based on any culture and language. Filmy/movie/commercial songs are not allowed. Only traditional folk songs are allowed.
- Time allowed maximum 3-5 minutes. The participation will be considered disqualified if it exceeds 5 minutes or is vulgar/obscene or socially unacceptable.

2. WHAT'S YOUR STORY 10 AM onwards

- Maximum 5 individual entries per school are allowed.
- Time allowed is 60 Minutes and Words Limit for essay is 500-750
- A visual image will be shown on college Facebook profile (Ggnimt Cllge <https://m.facebook.com/profile.php?id=100009115375035>) and website (www.ggnimtdh.org).
- The students will be asked to write a story on the basis of the image. e.g. an accident site and submit it through an email within stipulated timings.
- The judgement will be on the basis of thinking style, command on language, idea expression, creativity etc.
- The participant can write story in any language (English, Punjabi or Hindi).
- The story must mention the decision to solve the problem with justification.
- The link for submitting the write up will be shared with registered participants only via whatsapp. The link will remain active for half an hour only.

3. PAPER READING CONTEST 11 AM onwards

- Maximum 2 individual entries from each institution.
- The event will be online through Zoom or Google Meet.
- The participant will read out from the pre-written article on the given theme.
- Theme is "My Earth – My Responsibility".
- Time allowed is 3-4 minutes.
- The student should use the WRITE-UP neatly hand-written/typed. A copy of the same will be submitted to panel of judges through an email a day before the event. The email id will be shared with registered participants via whatsapp.
- Language can be English/Hindi/ Punjabi for presentation.
- The criteria for judgement will be content, visual, verbal & vocal elements of communication.

4. POWERPOINT PRESENTATION 10 AM onwards

- Maximum 3 individual entries per school are allowed.
- The activity will be online through Zoom or Google Meet.
- Use of Power Point Presentation is must.
- Time allowed is 4-6 minutes.
- The participant can present the topic in any language (English, Punjabi or Hindi).
- Participants will be judged on the basis of content, design of PPT, way of presentation and confidence. Students have an option of using the paper along with the presentation.
- The various topics are:
 - Technology : Enabler or disrupter?
 - Startups as a game changer
 - Data privacy in digital world
 - Robots Vs Humans

5. SOLO DANCE 10 AM onwards

- Maximum 2 individual entries per school are allowed.
- The participant will send a recorded video. Only dancing quality will be main consideration for judgement. The dance will be played on Facebook profile one by one for judgement. All participants will stay active on Facebook during the event.
- The participant must be appropriately dressed for category he/she is dancing in.
- Time limits – maximum 5 minutes
- Different categories are Ballet, baton, cheerleading, contemporize, folkloric, lyrical.
- Participants will be judged on the basis of steps, rhythm, expression and costume.
- The link for submitting the video will be shared with the registered participants only.

6. JUST2MIN 10 AM onwards

- The activity will be online through Zoom or Google Meet.
- Maximum 2 individual entries per school are allowed.
- Topic will be given on the spot. Two minutes preparation time will be given to each participant.
- Participant is expected to speak on the topic for 2 minutes. If time exceeds 2 minutes, participant will be disqualified.
- Participant can speak in any language (English, Punjabi or Hindi).
- Participant will be judged on fluency, creativity of ideas and continuity in speech etc.

7. FLOWER ARRANGEMENT 10 AM onwards

- The activity will be online through Zoom or Google Meet.
- Maximum 2 individual entries per school are allowed.

- Time allowed is 60 minutes.
- It should be theme based as decided by participants.
- Participants will use their own material.
- The flowers should be either fully fresh or fully artificial.
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8. DECLAMATION 11 AM onwards

- The activity will be online through Zoom or Google Meet.
- Maximum 2 individual entries per school are allowed.
- Time allowed is 3-4 minutes.
- Language can be English/Hindi/ Punjabi.
- The criteria for judgement will be visual, verbal & vocal elements of communication.
- The topics are:
 - Emotional Quotient: Need of the hour
 - Future of Coalition government
 - Use of social media to portray one's digital personality
 - Future of online classrooms

9. PROBLEM SOLVING USING C/C++ 11 AM onwards

- The activity will be online through Zoom or Google Meet.
- Maximum 3 teams per school are allowed. A team can comprise of two students.
- Problem will be given on the spot. Participants will be given 1 hour to develop the code.
- Code must be developed in C/C++ only.
- Teams will have to submit the developed code as a notepad file after 1 hour.
- Each team will be give 2-3 minutes to explain the code developed by them.

10. JEWEL CRAFT 11 AM onwards

- The activity will be online through Zoom or Google Meet.
- Maximum 3 individual entries per school are allowed.
- Maximum time allowed is 1 hour.
- Participants have to make jewelry (a necklace or a choker with a pair of earrings).
- Participants can use beads, pearls, stones, thread, doris or clay as per their choice and creativity. They can also use wires, threads, loops, rings and locks etc as need to assemble the jewelry.
- The criteria for judgement is creativity, decoration process, authenticity, neatness and workmanship.

11. FUNK WITH JUNK 11 AM onwards

- The activity will be online through Zoom or Google Meet.
- Maximum 3 individual entries per school are allowed.
- Maximum time allowed is 1 hour.

- Participants have to one useful item out of waste material such as wool, cartons, plastic bottles, magazines, newspapers, buttons, bangles, ice cream sticks, CDs, old wireframes, toy parts etc
- Other than waste material glue/fevicol, pins, colours, lace, scissors, thread etc can be used to enhance and give finishing to art work.
- The criteria for judgement is creativity, workmanship, innovation, usability/practicality of object made and timely completion.

12. A WALK OF PRIDE 11 AM onwards

- The theme for dress-up and walk is Patriotic.
- Maximum 3 individual entries per school are allowed.
- Participant has to shoot his/her short film of upto 2 minutes of doing a walk.
- Participant has to say 2-3 lines about the attire in any language (English/Hindi/Punjabi).
- The videos will be played on Facebook page of the college one by one for judgement. All participants will stay active on Facebook during the event.
- The criteria for judgement is attire, creativity, theme based presentation and walk.
- The link for submitting the video will be shared with the registered participants only.

13. NAPKIN ORIGAMI 11 AM inwards

- The activity will be online through Zoom or Google Meet.
- Maximum 3 individual entries per school are allowed.
- Maximum time allowed is 30 minutes.
- Participants have to create origami using napkins (cotton/ramie) on the table using various types of folds.
- The criteria of judgement is creativity, technical napkin folding, neatness and orderliness.
