PAYMENT DETAILS

Payments should be made through cash at office or by digital payment. GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS Aims and Scope

Manuscripts will be accepted for publication with the understanding that the content has not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere. The editor(s) reserve the right to refuse any material for presentation/publication and advises that authors should retain copies of submitted manuscript.

Copyright of published articles will be held by the organizers of the conference. No limitation will be placed on the personal freedom of authors to copy or to use the content in subsequent works. After publication, authors will receive a copy of the book in which their article appears.

Submission of Manuscripts

Spellings should follow either USA or British conventions and must be consistent throughout the manuscript.

Title Page

The cover page of the manuscript should include the title of the article, the authors' names, their affiliations, addresses, phone and e-mail addresses; the author to whom correspondence is to be sent should be clearly identified. No mention of authors' names should be made in the body of the paper, except where appropriate in citations and references.

Second Page

The title should be short (15 words maximum), informative and contain the major keywords. The second page should repeat the title and include a 100 - 150-word abstract.

Tables and figures

Tables and figures should be numbered consecutively in separate sequences. Each figure/table should have a self-explanatory title; desired location of each figure/table should be noted in the text. Numbering of tables and figures should be in Arabic numerals (e.g., 1, 2, 3) and be consistently cited between text and legend. All line diagrams and photographs are termed 'Figures'. Subheads should be kept concise, and the levels should be clearly differentiated. Footnotes should be used sparingly, and should not be used for citing references.

Autobiographical note (max. 100 words): Authors are requested to supply – on a separate page – details including their full name, highest qualification, current position and name of their organization along with major interest areas.

References

Kindly use standard formats of citing references. APA/Harvard System is recommended for use. The Literature reviewed if any, should be in chronological order.

Plagiarism Policy
