## GUIDELINES

• There is no participation fee for the event.

- Each Entry must be approved by respective principal or competent authority.
- Every student will get a certificate of participation apart from medals and trophies to winners.
- Participant must carry valid I-Card or letter from the school.
- **LAST DATE TO CONFIRM PARTICIPATION: 10 October 2025**

### Schools

Students from 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> class in all events

### Polytechnic

Second and final year students

- Kindly send your team according to schedule (mostly parallel running events). Schedule will not be changed to accommodate participation.
- Maximum two teachers can accompany their school/polytechnic contingent and contingent in-charge will be responsible for discipline.
- Reporting Time: 9 am
- Only students, currently on rolls, are allowed. Outsiders, professionals/former students/employees are not allowed.
- Nobody else except participants will be allowed at venue of competition.
- Any act of indiscipline or misbehavior will lead to disqualification of the participant(s) or full contingent, as the case may be.
- Any presentation against social/professional decorum will lead to disqualification.
- Many eatables will be additionally available on payment for participants. The teachers and accompanists will be served food by the host institution. No TA/DA will be paid to any participant or teacher(s).
- **GGNIMT** reserves the right to cancel any event.
- **GGNIMT** may retain all physical creations.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding in all events. Rules can be modified on the spot, if judges desire the same. No dispute will be entertained in this regard.
- All entries will have to be submitted in prescribed format in advance. On the spot entries may not be entertained.
- The competition in all events is common for school and polytechnic students.

## SUMMARY OF EVENT RULES

### WHAT'S YOUR STORY

- A visual image will be shown. Time allowed: 60 Minutes, Words Limit: 500-750
- The students will be asked to write a story on the basis of the image. e.g. an accident site
- The judgement will be on the basis of thinking style, command on language, idea expression, creativity etc.
- The participant can write story in any language (English, Punjabi or Hindi).
- The story must mention the decision to solve the problem with justification.
- Maximum 2 students per institution can participate. Every entry will be considered individually.

### JUST 2 MIN

- Only 2 students per institution are allowed in extempore. Every entry will be considered individually.
- Topic will be given on the spot which will be of very general nature.
- Participant is expected to speak on the topic for 2 minutes; warning bell will be sounded after one & half minutes. If the time exceeds 2 minutes, participant will be disqualified.
- Participant can speak in any language (English, Punjabi or Hindi).
- Participant will be judged on fluency, creativity of ideas and continuity in speech etc.
- Prelims will be conducted, if necessary.

### LET'S KNOW YOU KNOW (QUIZ)

- One team per institution comprising three participants each is allowed.
- There will be different rounds viz. Current Affairs, General Science, Know the People, Technology of Daily Life, Advertisements, Music etc
- There will be maximum 5 finalists. Screening will be done through *written prelims*.
- More rules will be shared on the spot.

### FABRIC PAINTING

- Maximum 2 individual entries per institution are allowed.
- Painting is to be done on a white cotton cloth of size 10 x 10 (inch). Participants must bring their own cloth.
- Participants must bring their own material: fabric colours, brushes, frames etc. Time allowed is 1 hour

### COLLAGE MAKING

- Theme for collage is 'Women need care'.
- Maximum 2 teams (maximum two members per team) per institution are allowed.
- Participants should bring their own material like A4 sheet, magazines, pictures, glue stick etc.
- Use of scissors is not allowed. Time allowed is one hour.

### RANGOLI

- Maximum 2 team entries (i.e. 1-3 members in each team) from each institution are allowed.
- Theme will be provided on the spot. Maximum 30x30 inches size will be available for preparing Rangoli.
- Only Dry material is allowed. Participants have to bring their own material (Pulses, Saw Dust, Colors, Pebbles, Flowers or any decorative material)
- Time allowed is 90 minutes. No accompanist is allowed.

### ESSAY WRITING

- Maximum 2 individual entries from each institution. Every entry will be considered individually.
- Theme will be provided on the spot.
- The participants can use any of the three languages i.e. (English or Punjabi or Hindi).
- Duration will not be more than half an hour. Words Limit: 300-500

### POSTER MAKING

- Each institution may be represented by maximum 2 *individual* entries.
- Theme will be provided on the spot. Pasting of extra material will not be appreciated.
- Participants will bring their own material A4 sheet, pencils, colours, erasers, boards, colors)
- Maximum time allowed is 60 minutes.

### CARTOONING

- Maximum 2 *individual* entries from each institution. Every entry will be considered individually.
- Theme will be *Human against Nature*.
- Participants will bring their own A4 drawing sheet, pencils, colours, erasers, boards etc.)
- Maximum time allowed is 60 minutes.

### MEHNDI

- Maximum 2 *individual* entries per institution are allowed. One accompanying student is allowed whose *one hand up to forearm* on both sides will be used for applying Mehndi.
- Use of tattoos/stencils is prohibited. i.e. Any design / booklet/ template or helping material is not allowed.
- Participants will have to bring their own material like mehndi etc. Time allowed is 90 minutes.

### FACE PAINTING

- One team will comprise of two members viz. an artist and an accompanying student whose face is to be painted. Maximum three teams of 2 students each per institution are allowed.

- Theme has to be decided by the participants. Participants will bring their own material like colors and brushes. Time allowed is 90 minutes.

### **FOLK SONG (SOLO)**

- One entry per institution is allowed.
- Only three accompanists (musicians) are allowed. The participants can also bring pre-recorded music.
- Song may be based on any culture and language. Filmy/movie/commercial songs are not allowed. Only traditional folk songs are allowed.
- Time allowed maximum 3-5 minutes. First warning bell will be sounded after 3 minutes and second warning bell will be sounded after 5 minutes.
- The participation will be disqualified if it exceeds 5 minutes or is vulgar/obscene or socially unacceptable.

### **DANCING (SOLO)**

- Maximum 2 individual entries per institution are allowed
- Must be appropriately dressed for category he/she is dancing in. Time limit – maximum 5 minutes
- Each entry must furnish their music on a pen drive.
- Different dance forms like ballet, baton, cheerleading, contemporize, folkloric, lyrical are allowed.
- Participants will be judged on the basis of steps, rhythm, expression and costume.

### **GROUP DANCE**

- One entry per institution is allowed. (2-10 members per group). Must be appropriately dressed.
- Time limits – maximum 8-10 minutes. Each entry must furnish their music on a pen drive.
- Group can present folk dance/contemporary/Bollywood style. Props can be used.

### **FLOWER ARRANGEMENT**

- Two teams comprising maximum two members per institution are allowed.
- Time allowed is 60 minutes. It should be theme based as decided by participants.
- Participants will bring their own material. The flowers should be either fully fresh or fully artificial.

### **PAPER READING CONTEST**

- The participant will read out from the article on the given theme.
- Theme is “Deforestation and degradation” or “Reviving Punjab”. Time allowed is 3-4 minutes.
- Maximum 2 *individual* entries from each institution. The student should bring the write-up neatly hand- written/typed. A copy of the same will be submitted to judges.
- Language can be English/Hindi/ Punjabi for presentation.

### **ON THE SPOT CAMERA TRICKS**

- Bring your own Digital camera or Mobile Phone with a good quality camera.
- The Card will be formatted before the start of the event, if required.
- Theme will be given on the spot. 3 photographs will be submitted for judgment by each contestant.
- Two participants per institution (individual entries) allowed.

### **SALAD COMPETITION**

- A team of 3 students. Two teams per institution are allowed.
- Students will bring their own material
- Theme will be of participants’ choice
- Carving, nutritional value, ease to serve, aesthetic sense, presentation etc will form the basis of the judgement.
- Time allowed 90 minutes.

### **POWER POINT PRESENTATIONS**

- Use of MS PowerPoint Presentation is must.
- Main theme for presentation will be “Freedom from Stress” OR “Guru Nanak’s philosophy and its relevance in present times”. However, the student is free to choose any sub-theme within the broad gamut.
- Time allowed is 4-6 minutes.
- The participant can present the topic in any language (English, Punjabi or Hindi).
- The participant would bring his /her own Soft Copy of presentation in a Pen Drive.
- **GGNIMT** will provide facilities of a projector & a laptop.
- Participants will be judged on the basis of content, design of PPT, way of presentation and confidence. Students have an option of using the paper along with the presentation.
- Only 2 participants from an institution are allowed. However, judgment will be for individual presentation.

### **CASE BASED GROUP DISCUSSION**

- A case study/write up/paragraph will be given for reading for 30 minutes.
- A group discussion of 10 minutes will be held on the basis of the case study.
- The judgment will be on the basis of ideas, sense of team spirit, command on language, behaviour and contribution in solution etc.
- Maximum *two individual* entries from each institution. Language: English, Punjabi or Hindi.

### **JEWEL CRAFT**

- A maximum 2 individual entries per school are allowed.
- The maximum time allowed is 60 minutes.

- The participants have to make jewelry (a necklace or a choker with a pair of earrings).
- The participants can use beads, pearls, stones, thread, doris or clay as per their choice and creativity. They can also use wires, threads, loops, rings, and locks etc. as need to assemble the jewelry.
- The criteria for judgement are creativity, decoration process, authenticity, neatness, and workmanship.

#### **FUNK WITH JUNK**

- A maximum of 2 teams with three members per school are allowed.
- The maximum time allowed is 60 minutes.
- The participants have to create one useful item out of waste material such as wool, cartons, plastic bottles, magazines, newspapers, buttons, bangles, ice cream sticks, CDs, old wireframes, toy parts, etc.
- Other than waste material, glue, pins, colors, lace, scissors, thread etc. can be used to give finishing to art work.
- The criteria for judgement are creativity, workmanship, innovation, usability/practicality of object made and timely completion.

#### **T-SHIRT PAINTING**

- A maximum of 2 *individual* entries per school are allowed.
- The maximum time allowed is 75 minutes.
- T-shirts must be blank and free from any prior designs/logos. Only original designs will be considered; no tracing or pre-printed stencils allowed. The painting must be done entirely during the contest
- The theme is 'Ek Bharat Shresht Bharat'
- Students will bring their own material

#### **NAPKIN FOLDING**

- A maximum of one team with two members per school is allowed.
- The maximum time allowed is 60 minutes.
- No pre-folded or prepared napkins allowed. No use of adhesives, pins, or clips is allowed.
- Folding should be done manually – no tools are permitted.
- Participants must bring their own: Cloth napkins (minimum size: 18"x18"; color: plain or theme-based), Base items for display (e.g., tray, cutlery, glass, or plate – optional for presentation), Ironed napkins are recommended for neat folds.
- Decorative props (like glitter, lights) are allowed.

#### **e-POSTER DESIGNING**

- A maximum of 3 *individual* entries per school are allowed.
- Venue will be GGNIMT Computer Centre. No pen drive, email or any pre-downloaded images will be allowed. Internet facility will be provided. No directly downloaded content will be used as such without modification.
- Tools Allowed: Basic Canva, Paint 3D only.
- The maximum time allowed is 60 minutes.
- The theme is 'Unnat Bharat- Unnat Pind'.
